1 What is International Student Barometer?

International Student Barometer (ISB) is an online survey targeted to (international) students in higher education institutions. It aims to provide feedback from students (both international and domestic) on their study experience. The questionnaire contains questions about students' satisfaction on application process, arrival, learning experience, accommodation and living in the host city, and support services.

ISB is produced and run by I-graduate, an international benchmarking and research service specialized in education.

Autumn 2014, over 200 universities in 18 countries participated in the ISB survey and almost 165 000 international students responded the questionnaire. The majority of participating institutions are from Anglo-American countries. In Europe, the participating institutions are from UK (61 institutions), Finland (22), Netherlands (8), Estonia (7), Sweden (6), Ireland (3), Germany (2), Italy (2), and Denmark (1). The other participating institutions come from Australia (35), USA (30), Canada (13), Hong Kong (6), Malaysia (5), Singapore (4) and New Zealand (1). These form the global ISB benchmark for Finnish universities.

In Finland, 11 universities and 11 universities of applied sciences participated in the ISB survey in autumn 2014 and sent the questionnaire to their international students. A total of 6 339 international students responded from a Finnish university.

This paper summarises the responses given by the international students in Finnish institutions.








Funding of studies (All students, N=5157) % of students using the source of funding




How satisfied are you with all aspects of your institution experience? (All students, N=6339) %




Would you recommend the institutions to other students thinking of applying here? (Full degree students, N=3656) %

Would you now take the same decision regarding your study destination/choice of institution? (Full degree students, N=3603) %




Would you now take the same decision regarding your study destination/choice of institution? (Exchange students, N=1557) %




Before commencing your studies, where did you study previously (most recently)?



What is the highest educational/academic degree prior to your departure to Finland? (Full degree students, N=3527) %




Where were you studying or working before you began this current course of study? (Full degree students, N=1188) %




Before commencing your current course of study, how long were you in this country? (If "this country" selected before, N=231), number of students



How important were the following factors when deciding where to study? (First year full degree and exchange students, N=1207-1437) % of respondents with the factor important or very important




How important were the following factors when deciding where to study? (First year full degree and exchange students in Finland and students in the global survey) % of respondents with the factor important or very important




Which of the following helped you decision to choose this institution? (First year full degree and exchange students, N=1890) %




Which was more important in your decision of where to study? (First year full degree students, N=1184) %

Was Finland your first choice for your international study? (First year full degree students, N=1181) %




Was Finland your first choice for your international study? (Exchange students, N=320) %






How long did you wait between applying and receiving your offer from this institution? (First year full degree students, N=1396) %




How satisfied were you with this response time? (First year full degree students, N=1443) %




How did you apply to your current course at this institution? (First year full degree students, N=1442) %



Please rate the service you received from the education agent/consultant. (If applied via education agent OR if education agent/consultant helped to choose institution, N=113) %




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? (Full degree students who applied via education agent or agent helped, N=69-81) % of students agreeing or strongly agreeing




During the visa application process, how satisfied were you with the following? (First year full degree and exchange students, N=751-892) % of satisfied or very satisfied



How satisfied were you with the overall arrival experience? (First year full degree and exchange students, N=1810) %




How satisfied were you with the following regarding when you first arrived at the institution. (First year full degree and exchange students, N=110-1760) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied were you with the following regarding when you first arrived at the institution. (First year full degree and exchange students, N=110-1760) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied are you with the learning experience at this stage of the year? (All students, N=6130) %




How satisfied are you with the following – teaching? (All students, N=4526-5475) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied are you with the following – teaching? (All students) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied are you with the following – studies? (All students, N=792-5396) % of satisfied or very satisfied


How satisfied are you with the following – facilities? (All students, N=3119-5446) % of satisfied or very satisfied






In a normal 7 day week, how many hours do you spend on the following? Please give an approximate estimate. (All students) %




To what extent has your course challenged you to? (Full degree students, N=2822) %



To what extent has your course challenged you to? (Exchange students, N=1600) %




To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? (Full degree students, N=2780) %






How satisfied are you with the living experience? (All students, N=5564) %




How satisfied are you with the following – accommodation and living costs? (All students, N=2327-5321) % % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied are you with the following – accommodation and living costs? (All students) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied are you with the following – social? (All students, N=4614-5278) % of satisfied or very satisfied








How satisfied are you with the support services? (All students, N=5151) %






How satisfied are you with the following? (All students, N=92-4764) % of satisfied or very satisfied



How satisfied are you with the following? (All students) % of satisfied or very satisfied




How satisfied you are with the following? (All students, N=5038-5139) % of satisfied or very satisfied




What employment/careers support do you expect from the institutions? (All students, N=5162) %



To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? (All students, N=4940-5129) % of agreeing or agreeing strongly




Would you recommend Finland to other students thinking of applying here? (Full degree students, N=3601) %




Would you recommend Finland to other students thinking of applying here? (Exchange students, N=1560) %
