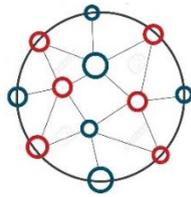

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Our focus (Strategic Plan 2018-2022)

- Enhanced cross-country peer learning and exchange of knowledge and best practices.

- Elevated Africa's voice on education priorities at regional, continental and global levels.

- Greater collaboration, coordination and improved capacity of countries and actors.

Key areas:

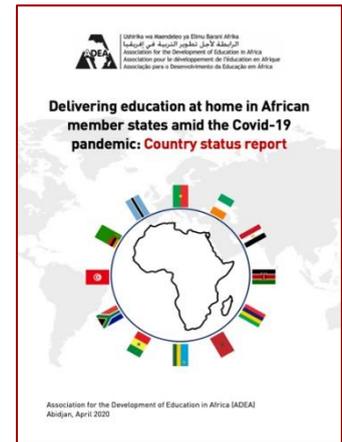
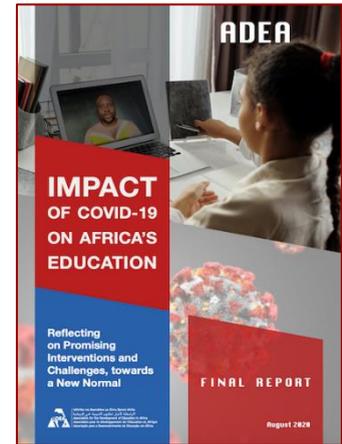

Our response to COVID-19

- Produced **2 study reports on country experiences**, supporting interventions & reopening of learning institutions in 2020.
- Produced **5 synthesis reports and 5 live trackers** on evidence of policy and practice responses to COVID-19 in 40 African countries (KIX Observatory) in 2021:
- Developed **3 Remote Education Benchmarking Toolkits** to support improved resilience of education systems in Africa in providing inclusive and quality education in times of crises.
- **Produced and disseminated several knowledge products** from the evidence generated (policy briefs, blogs, newsletters, articles).



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Our focus for 2022

1. Development of **ADEA Strategic Plan 2023-2027**.
2. Development of **ICQN Strategic Frameworks and Action Plans**:
 - a) Early Childhood Development & Secondary Education.
 - b) Teaching and Learning & Technical and Vocational Skills Development.
 - c) Higher Education and Scientific Research, Mathematics and Science Education, and Peace Education.
3. Organizing **ADEA 2022 Triennale**:
 - a) Education sector's resilience to COVID-19 pandemic and other crises.
 - b) Foundational literacy and numeracy.
 - c) Technical and Vocational Skills Development, with digitalization.
 - d) Higher education and scientific research.
4. Organizing **3rd High-Level Policy Dialogue Forum** on Skills in Higher Education.
5. **Evidence generation and knowledge mobilization.**
6. **Strengthening country capacity** in data management and utilization for informed policy, planning and programme implementation.



Proposed involvement in new EU-Africa Strategy

Overall:

- Supporting the African Union in advocating for **contextualizing and mainstreaming projects** under the new strategy in **regional education programmes and national education sector plans**, for ownership and sustainability.

Specific areas:

- Enhancing **inclusive quality education** – especially for vulnerable groups that include children in conflict affected areas – through digital transformation as part of enhancing the sector's resilience to crises such as COVID-19.
- Enhancing **foundational learning** and acquisition of **critical knowledge and skills**.
- Enhancing **research and innovation capacities**, particularly for women and youth, in key areas of development.
- Promoting **peace, governance and skills mobility** through education.



Proposed involvement in Finland's Africa Strategy – 1

Aligned to the strategic priority to '**develop relations with** African countries, the African Union (AU) and **regional organizations** during the next few years'.

Is in line with Finland's Africa Strategy call to embrace "**Ubuntu Concept**".

Proposed areas of involvement through education:

1. Promoting peace and security:

- Research and innovation – especially in addressing the learning crisis in Africa to promote peace and security.
- Inclusive peace processes involving women and youth and leveraging the role of traditional and religious leaders.
- Development of African crisis management and conflict prevention capabilities.
- Prevention and combatting violent extremism and radicalization, terrorism, human trafficking and violence against women.



Proposed involvement in Finland's Africa Strategy – 2

2. Promoting trade, investments and job-creating green growth:

- Intensifying cooperation in the field of technology and innovation - e.g., the impact of Artificial Intelligence on future work.
- Improving educational opportunities, especially in the field of vocational education and training, for competitiveness and innovations that promote sustainable development.

3. Enhancing relations between peoples and communities:

- Partnership through exchange studies and exchange of researchers between higher education institutions, research organizations and think tanks.
- Developing Africa's education sector at primary and secondary level, including vocational education and training.
- Supporting capacities of higher education institutions and research institutes to promote knowledge, innovations and sustainable development.
