
FinCEED facilitates the deployment of Finnish education sector expertise for the use of developing countries and multilateral actors.

Expert assignments can encompass a wide range of opportunities, including shortterm missions lasting up to six months, policy support, education expert keynotes, webinars, training, and various other modes of support to drive effective implementation within the education sector. FinCEED focuses on supporting requests in systemic and policy-level development, for example in areas like teacher training, inclusive education, curriculum development, assessment and evaluation, digital learning, and school meals in early childhood education, primary and secondary education and vocational education and training.

FinCEED manages an expert directory and recruits education sector specialists for tasks and missions through this directory.

The experts registered for the directory have strong professional experience in different fields of the Finnish education sector and in international cooperation.

FinCEED brings together education specialists from different fields and organisations by providing events, trainings and networking opportunities.
