Eväitä laadukkaaseen vastaanottoon ja isännöintiin korkeakoulun kansainvälistymisen eduksi	Posterisessiossa keskitytään korkeakoulujen kansainvälisten osaajien vastaanottokäytänteisiin ja avataan laadukkaan ja tuloksellisen isännöinnin laajempaa merkitystä korkeakoululle. Sessio tarjoaa esimerkkejä suomalaisessa korkeakoulussa vierailneiden kansainvälisten tutkijoiden ja korkeakoulun isäntien näkemyksistä sekä eväitä ja parhaita käytänteitä korkeakoulun vastaanottostrategian ja -prosessien kehittämisen tueksi.

We offer world-class tools for Finnish researchers, such as high-performance computing and data services. Researchers have access to our services through CSC's research infrastructures and through international projects in which we participate. The European LUMI supercomputer is one example of this. CSC has a wide international project and membership portfolio. We want to support the internationalisation of Finnish researchers and universities and strengthen existing cooperation with international partners. Higher education institutions could make wider use of CSC's international activities and networks. Our goal for the coming years is to raise awareness among higher education institutions of the opportunities and support provided by CSC in international activities.
