

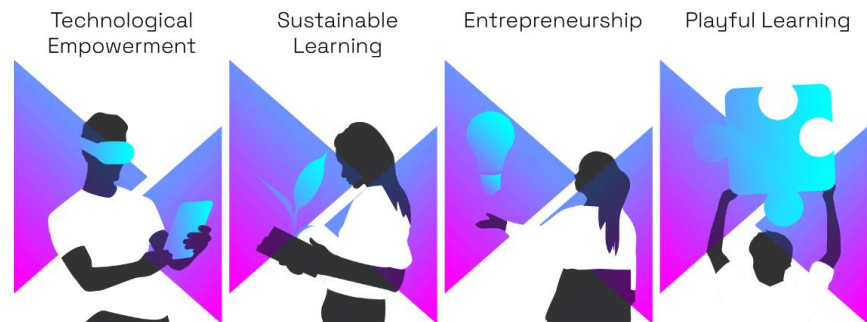

How did we get started?

- Find the right partners
 - Onepager – described our idea in one (max two) pages
 - Distributed it through our network – and the CDEU-office network
 - Network!!
 - Got in direct contact with partners who we have written applications with earlier (but never got a project together with!)
 - Be critical!
 - Choose partners that can provide knowledge and expertise to things you are not able to yourself or in your organisation!



How did we get started?

- Need to be trustworthy on communication and impact (exploitation and dissemination)
- Tested them!
 - Met in Bruxelles to do some of the writing assignments
- Provide a clear structure for the collaboration in the process
 - Meetings, deadlines, deliverables – alignment on the topics

 - We had the final work to finish up the application for submission

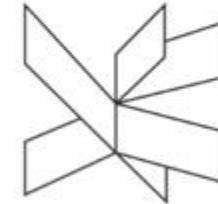

The project's objectives

1. Provide a beyond state-of-the-art mapping laying the ground for a common understanding of the four subjects and **establishing a strong network** of 30 pre- and in-service teachers as **a driver for mobility** during study visits and co-organized teaching events (five completed) across borders.
2. **Design, develop and try out 21st Century joint learning modules** for 200 pre- and in-service teachers in a “21st Century European Teacher co-education model” building on the mapping and establishment of the strong network.



The project's objectives

3. Provide recommendations for the 21st Century European Teacher Curriculum around the four subject areas through five learning modules (MOOCs) made available via eTwinning. A minimum of 150 pre- and in-service teachers will be enrolled in one or more of the MOOCs across countries.

4. Provide recommendations on the policy level by conducting five dialogue labs at national level with 30-50 participants from each country and an European workshop for a broad European network to inform relevant stakeholders.

The 21st Century European Teacher Co-education Model will be the framework to accommodate the objectives.



What then.... Yes - we got the project?

Then reality hit us!

- We needed to 'translate' the project proposal into implementation
 - One partner (School) had a new principal
 - The principal assigning the project was now at a small school, and would that work?
 - Teacher education in Denmark has changed... no absence for students!
 - How about the Italien School?



Don't get frustrated... but we need help!

- We have a project and a legal office to help
 - Get the EU system updated
 - Get all partners on the EU system
 - The new school – validation – assigning roles – amendment process
 - Get all partners to sign the DoH in the GAP
 - Economy – had to sign contracts before (not only GA)
 - Legal issues and contracts



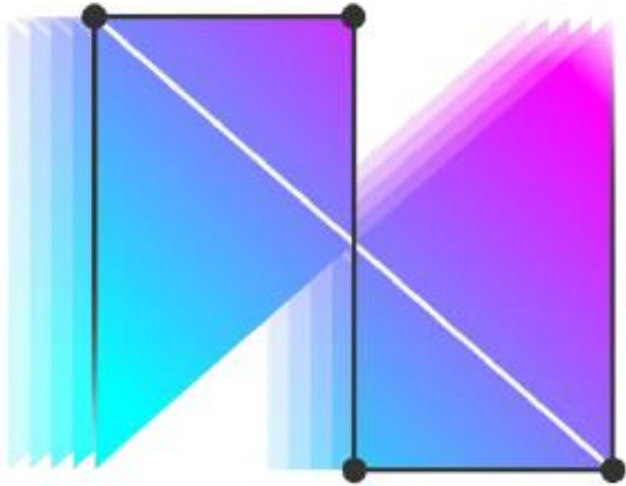
What have we learnt?

- Need to find the right partners early
 - Test as collaboration is important when to implement
- Have enough time to meet and involve partners
- Often circumstances will change before the proposal are accepted
- It is actually alright to say No!
