- **Dr. Miguel Lim, The University of Manchester**
Dr. Miguel Antonio Lim is a Senior Lecturer in Education and International Development and Co-convenor of the Higher Education Research Network at the Manchester Institute of Education, School of Environment, Education and Development at the University of Manchester, UK. He is a specialist in research and policy issues in international and transnational higher education. His research focuses on the challenges facing universities and national higher education systems in relation to internationalisation.

Anh Ngoc Quynh Phan received the Doctoral scholarship from The University of Auckland in 2018 and is currently a PhD candidate in Education at The University of Auckland, New Zealand. She contributes to books and journals of diverse topics, including English as a foreign language, teacher education and development, quality assurance, motherhood, and international students.
