<p>Coordinator</p> <p>Haaga-Helia University of Applied Sciences</p> <p>Kiia Lehtinen kiia.lehtinen@haaga-helia.fi</p>	<p>FI-RU-MOB Finnish-Russian Blended Mobility Network</p> <p>The aim of this project is to create opportunities for students of Haaga-Helia and Russian universities to develop their competence to work in the Finnish and Russian business environment, to network and establish contacts in Finland and in Russia with peers and the industry. The aim is also to increase the cooperation in teaching between the universities, and cooperation between the university and industry. Graduates who know the Finnish and Russian business environment are needed to contribute to the development of Finnish-Russian cooperation and trade. The project will also strengthen the visibility of Finnish university of applied sciences in Russia and the reputation of Haaga-Helia UAS as an internationally respected and recognized university of applied sciences.</p>
<p>Partners</p> <p>Saint Petersburg State University of Economics, Saint-Petersburg State University of Aerospace Instrumentation, Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University, Plekhanov Russian University of Economics</p>	<p>The project activities include long-term and short-term student mobilities that include physical and virtual periods, from Finland to Russia and from Russia to Finland, and short physical and virtual exchanges of teaching staff of Finnish and Russian universities. Finnish and Russian teachers create a joint course in marketing and business development, the course is a combination of in-class and virtual learning. During the course cooperation teachers develop and test various virtual pedagogical methods. The joint course cooperation enables students who are not able to travel to attend the course since it is offered virtually, teachers move. Companies operating in the Finnish-Russian trade are involved in the project in the role of commissioners of student projects. The activities are targeted to the students and teaching staff in aviation business, tourism and hospitality programmes.</p>
