






Incoming students to Finland 2016-2018




Incoming students to EU 2016-2018




Outgoing students from Finland 2016-2018




Outgoing students from EU 2016-2018

"Very satisfied" outgoing students (FI) by budget envelope




How did you find out about the possibility to study abroad with the Erasmus+ Programme?



Was your learning agreement signed by all parties before the start of the mobility?




- Yes, all parties signed it before the start

- The learning agreement was never signed


Was the selection procedure at your sending institution fair and transparent?




Did you receive the payments on time, in line with the dates mentioned in your grant agreement?



Academic recognition at sending institution




To what extent did the Erasmus+ grant cover overall expenses related to mobility period - *incoming students*




Would you have gone on Erasmus+ mobility abroad if you had not received an Erasmus+ grant?




"How satisfied were you with the way the receiving institution dealt with any questions, complaints or problems that may have come up during your participation in the programme?"






Did you gain knowledge and skills that you would not have gained in your sending institution?

I can easily imagine working in the country where I did my Erasmus+ period in the future



2016-2018 Incoming staff, 102 STA ja 66 STT

- 80% ensimmäistä kertaa liikkuvuusjaksolla
- 92 % erittäin tyytyväisiä "very satisfied"
- 98 % on oppinut uusista hyvistä käytänteistä ulkomaanjaksolla "have learned from good practises abroad"
