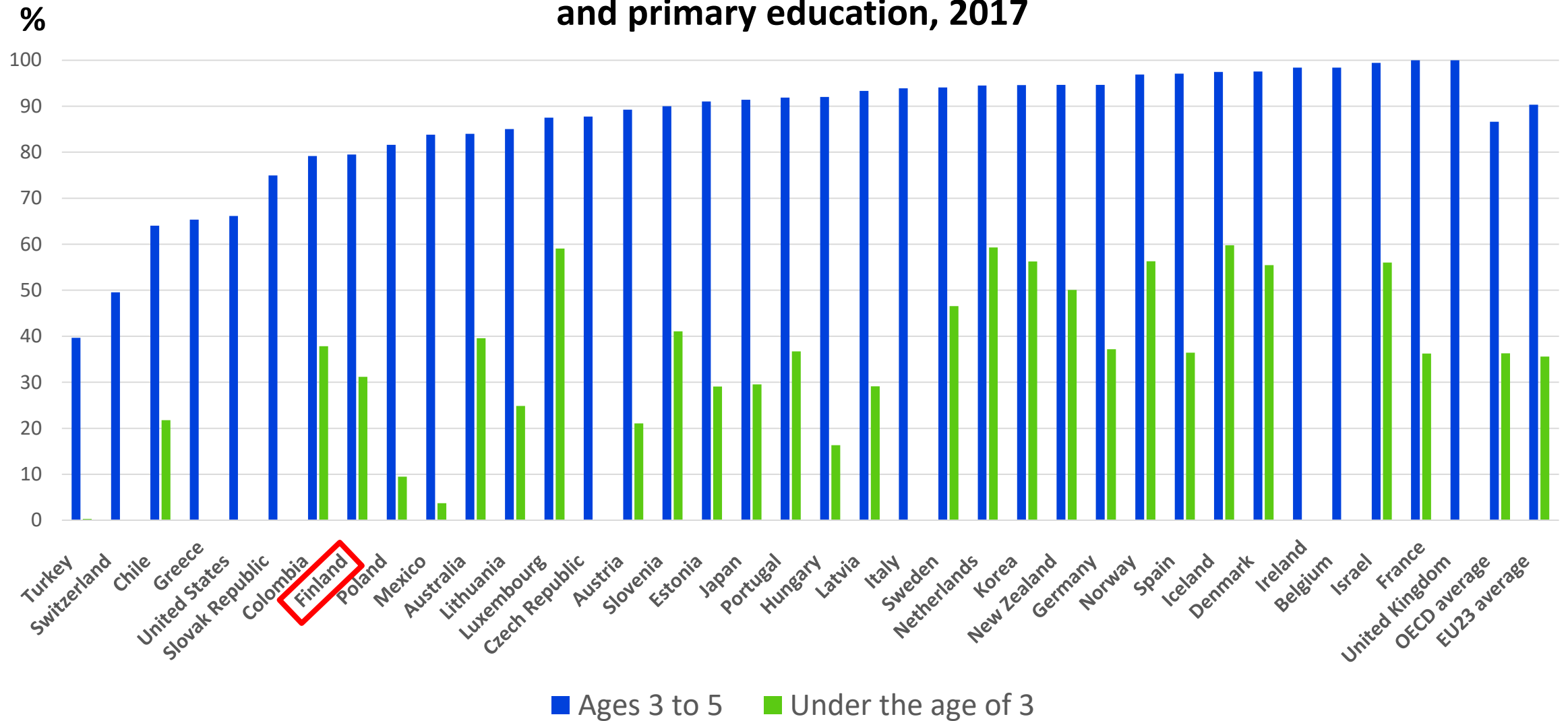
Education at a Glance (EaG)

 - a chapter dedicated to Target 4.5 of Sustainable Development Goal 4 on equity in education, providing an assessment of where OECD and partner countries stand in providing equal access to quality education at all levels
 - new indicators on equity in entry to and graduation from tertiary education, and the levels of decision-making in education systems

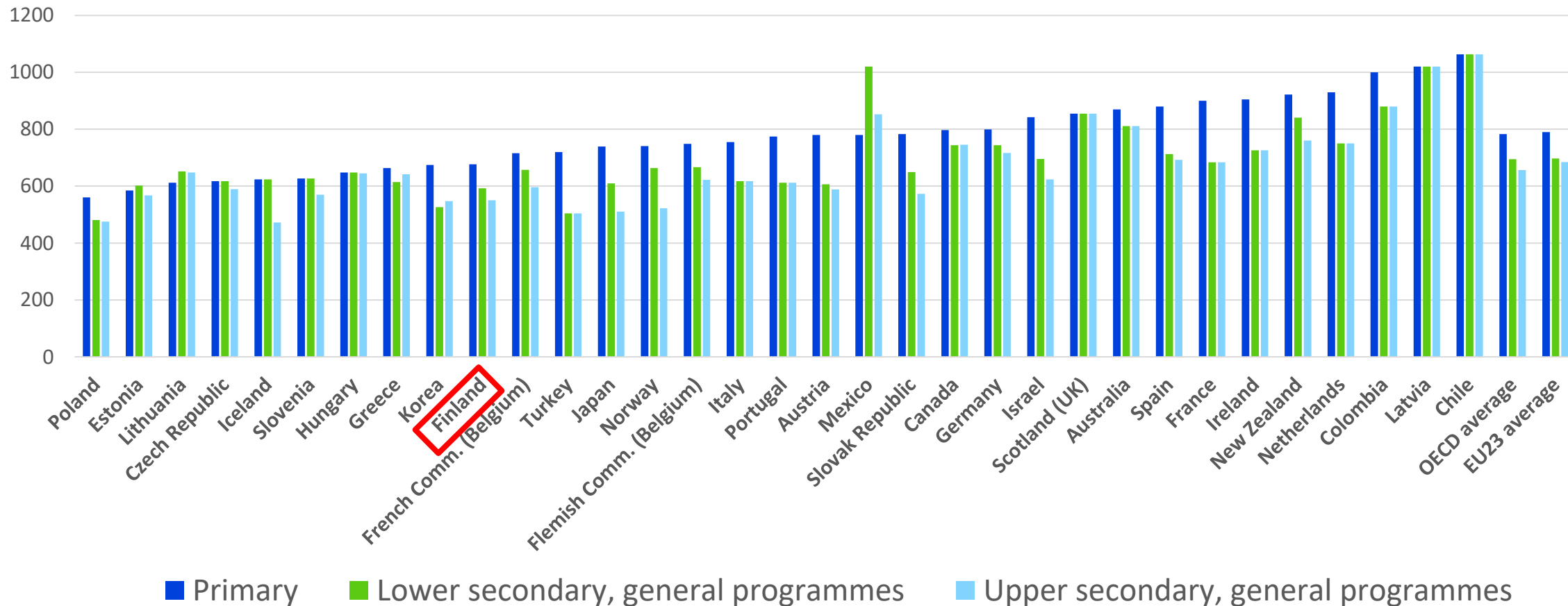
Enrolment rates in early childhood education and care and primary education, 2017

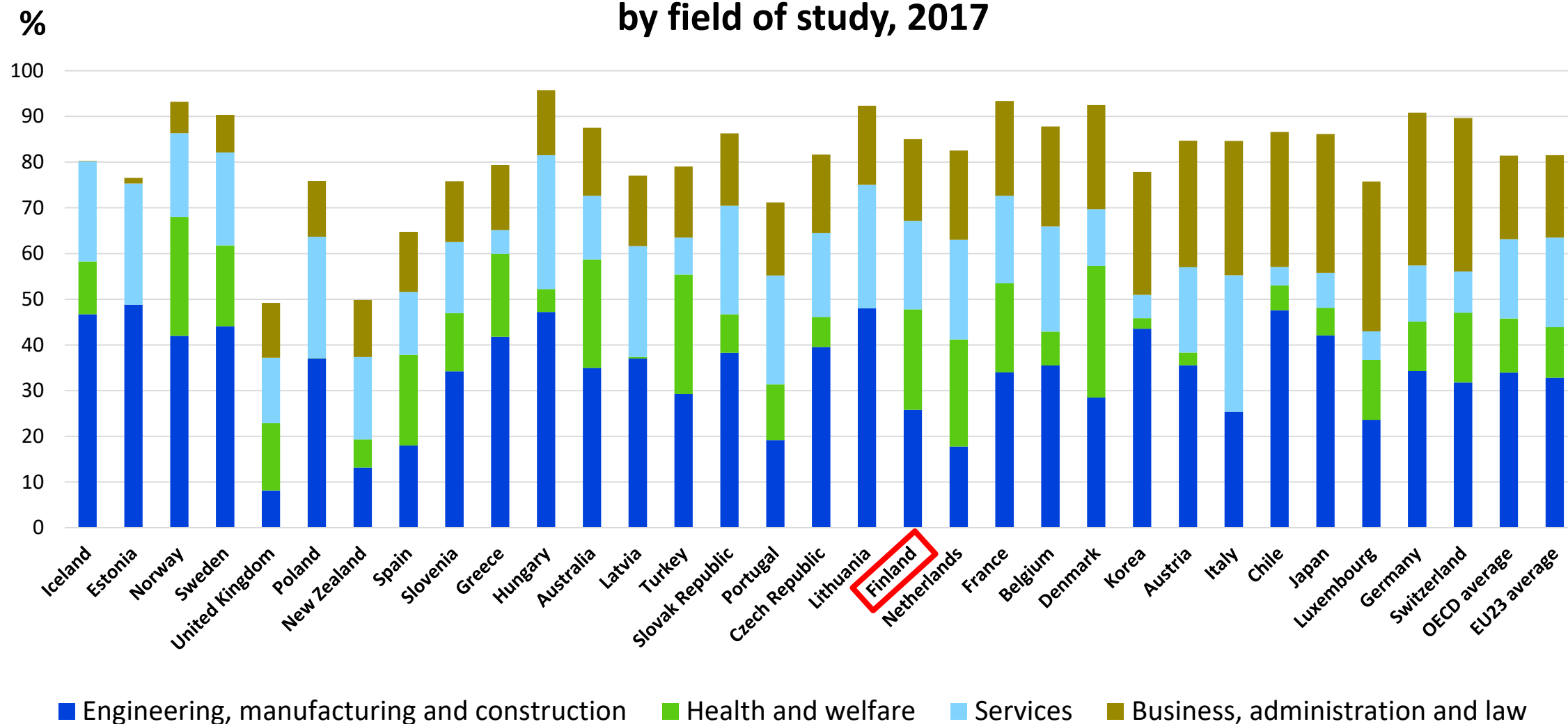
Number of statutory teaching time in 60-minute hours per year in public institutions by level of education, 2018

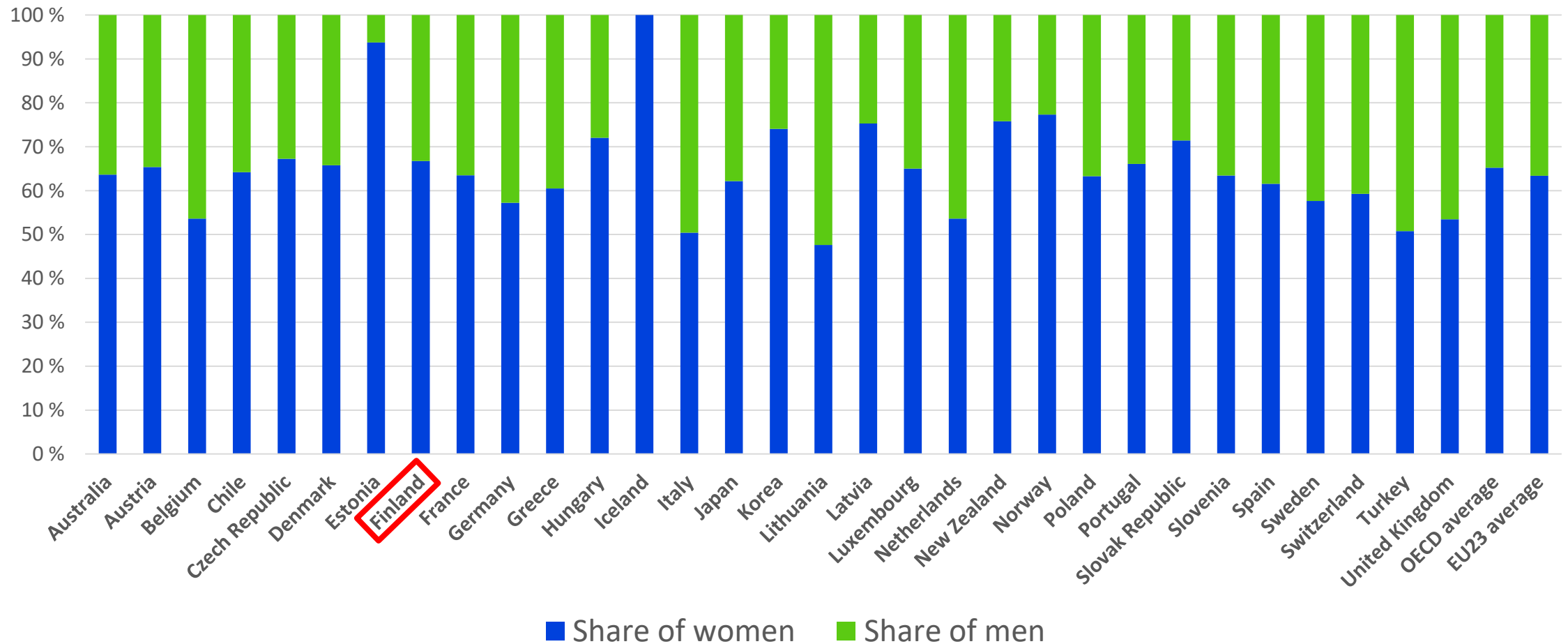
Upper secondary graduates from vocational programmes by field of study, 2017

Distribution of female and male upper secondary graduates from vocational programmes by field of study

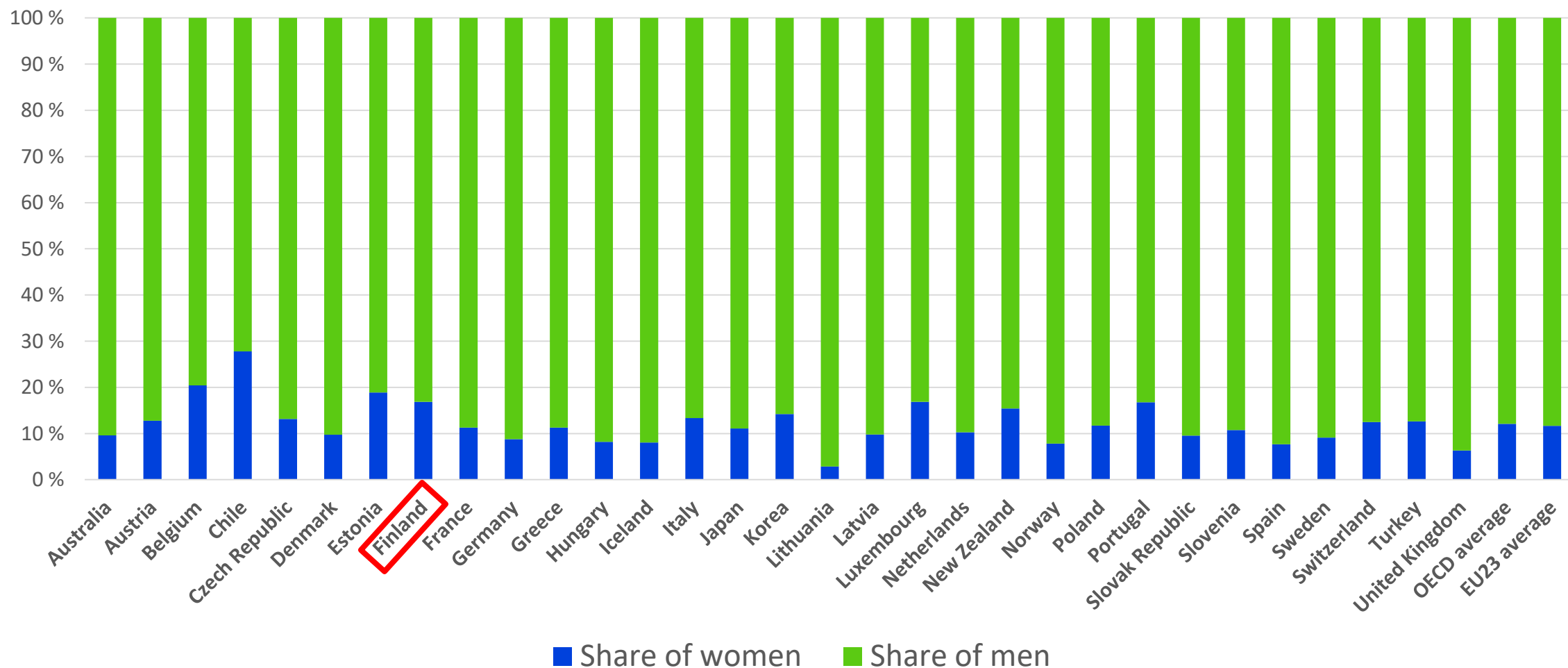

Distribution of female and male upper secondary graduates from vocational programmes by field of study

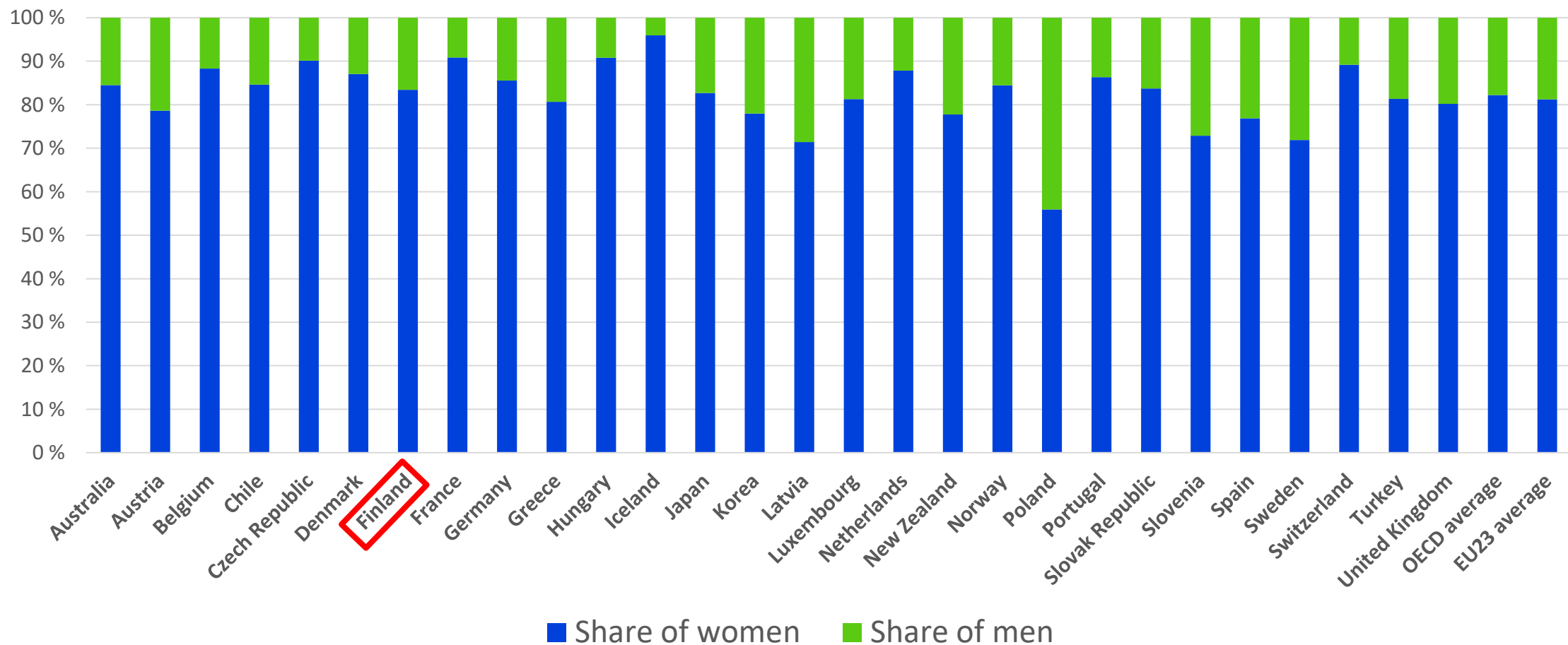
Engineering, manufacturing and construction, 2017

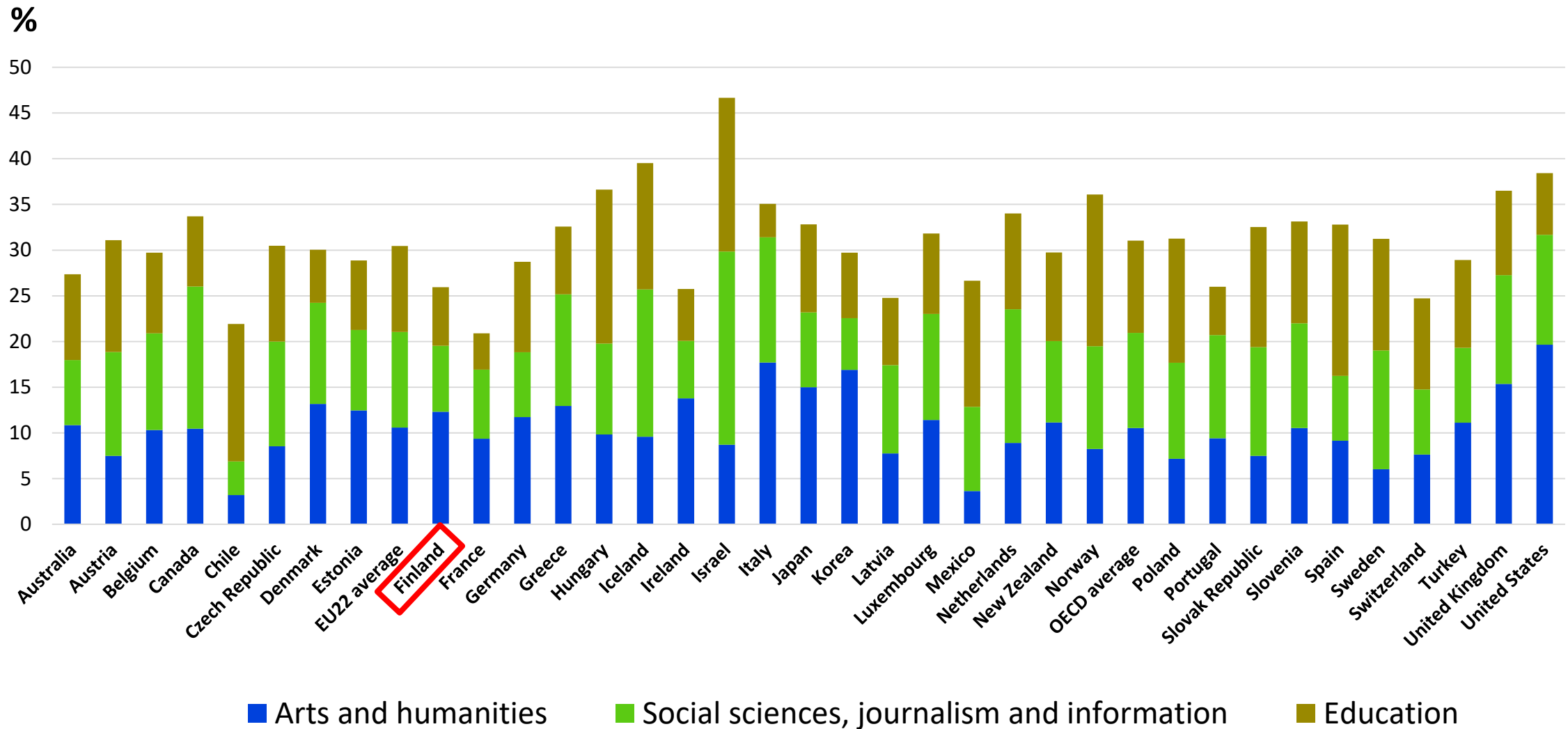
Distribution of female and male upper secondary graduates from vocational programmes by field of study

Health and welfare, 2017



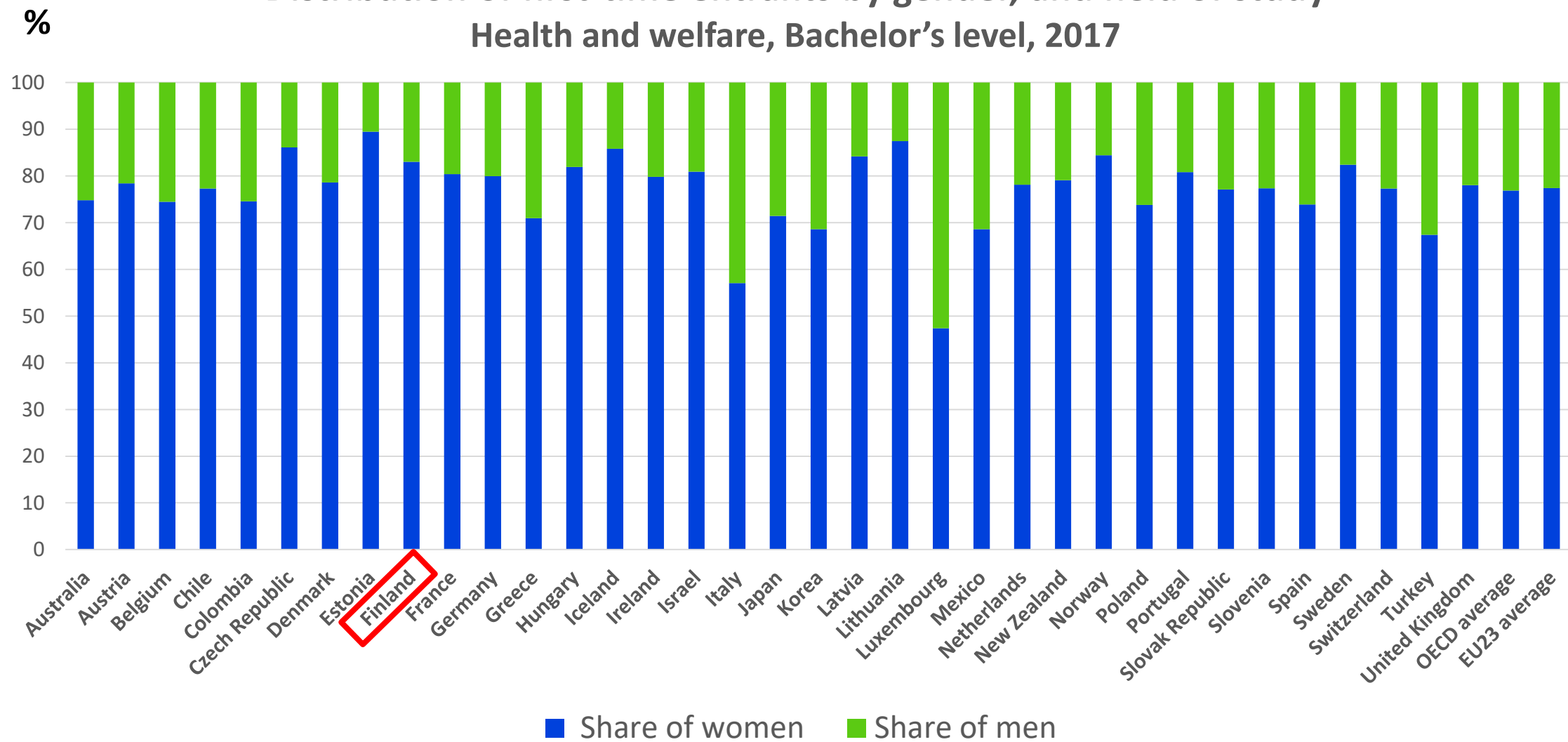

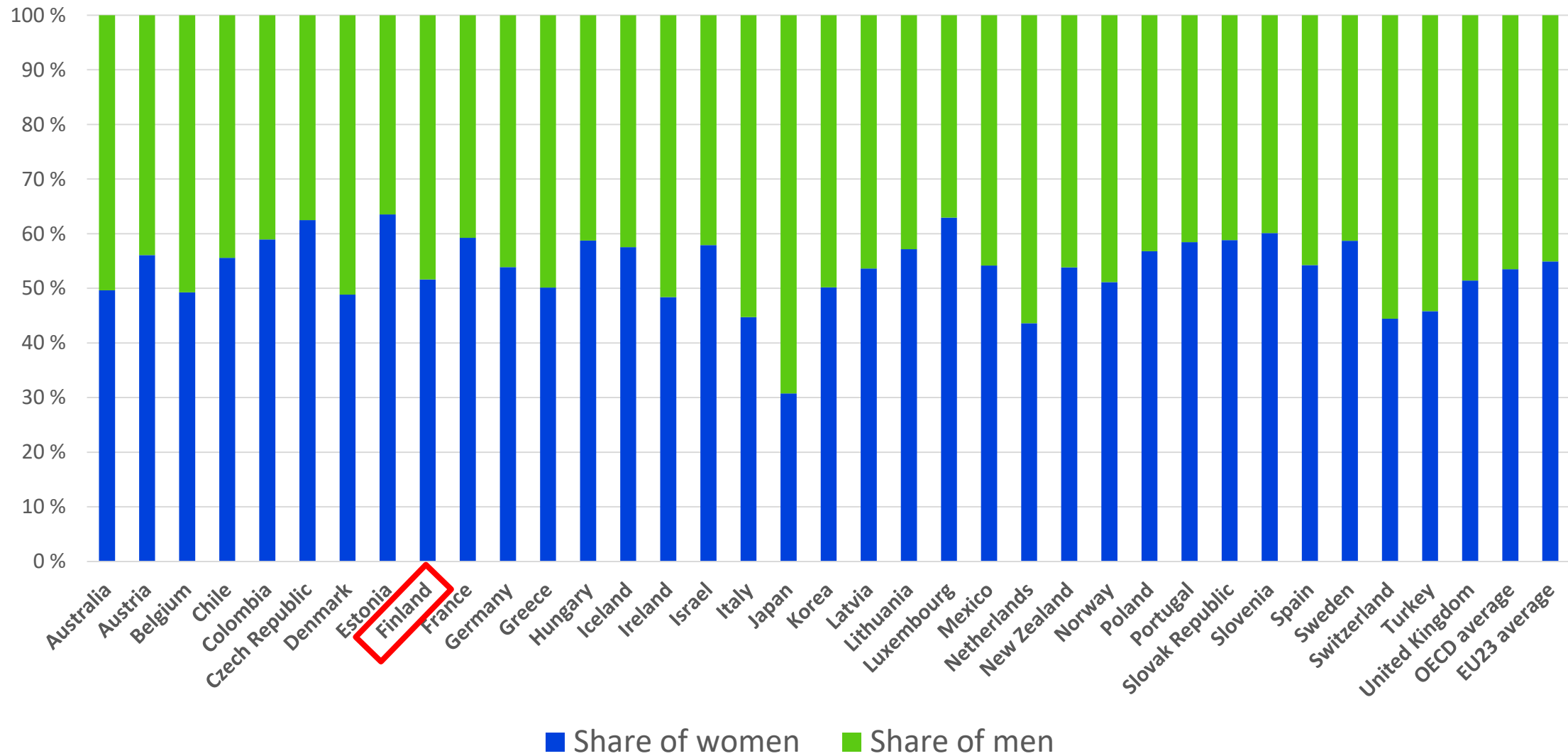
Distribution of first-time entrants by gender, and field of study Health and welfare, Bachelor's level, 2017

Business, administration and law, Bachelor's level, 2017



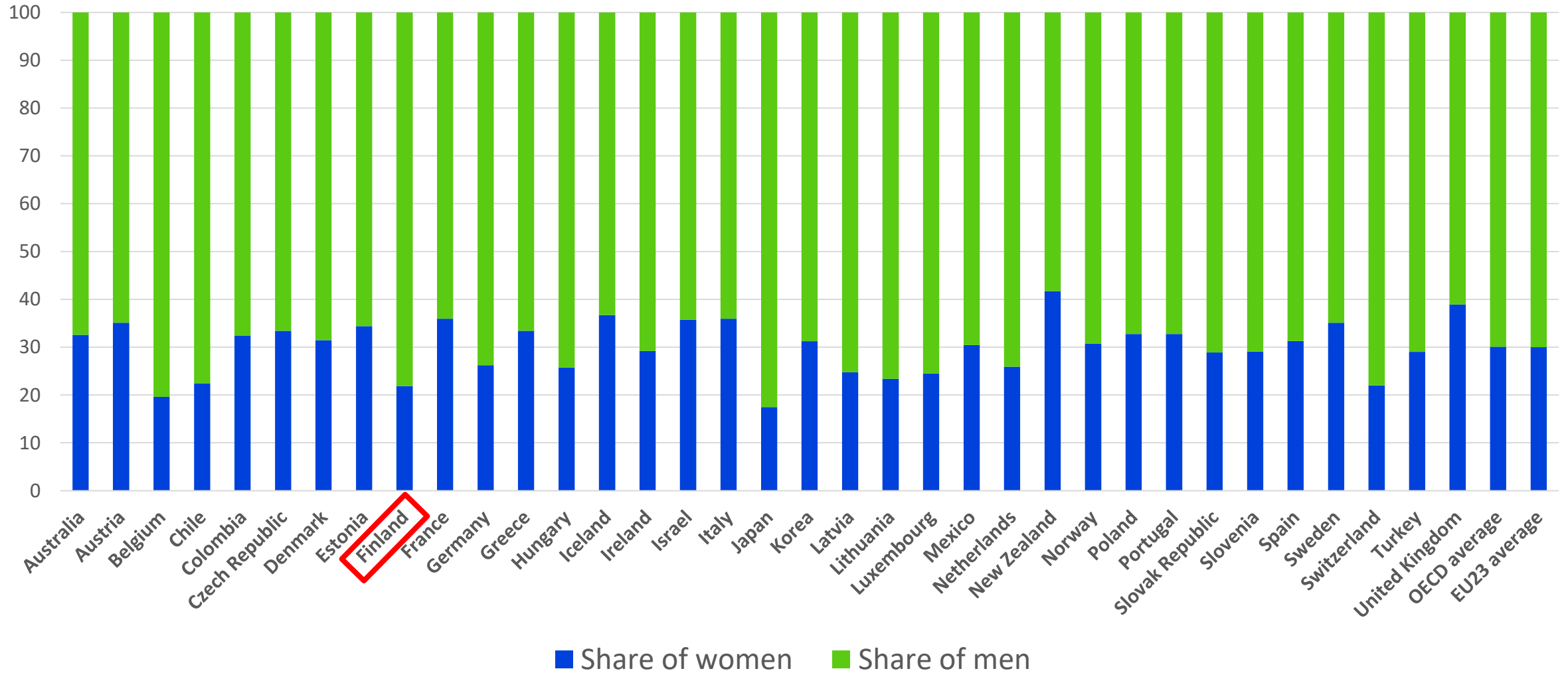

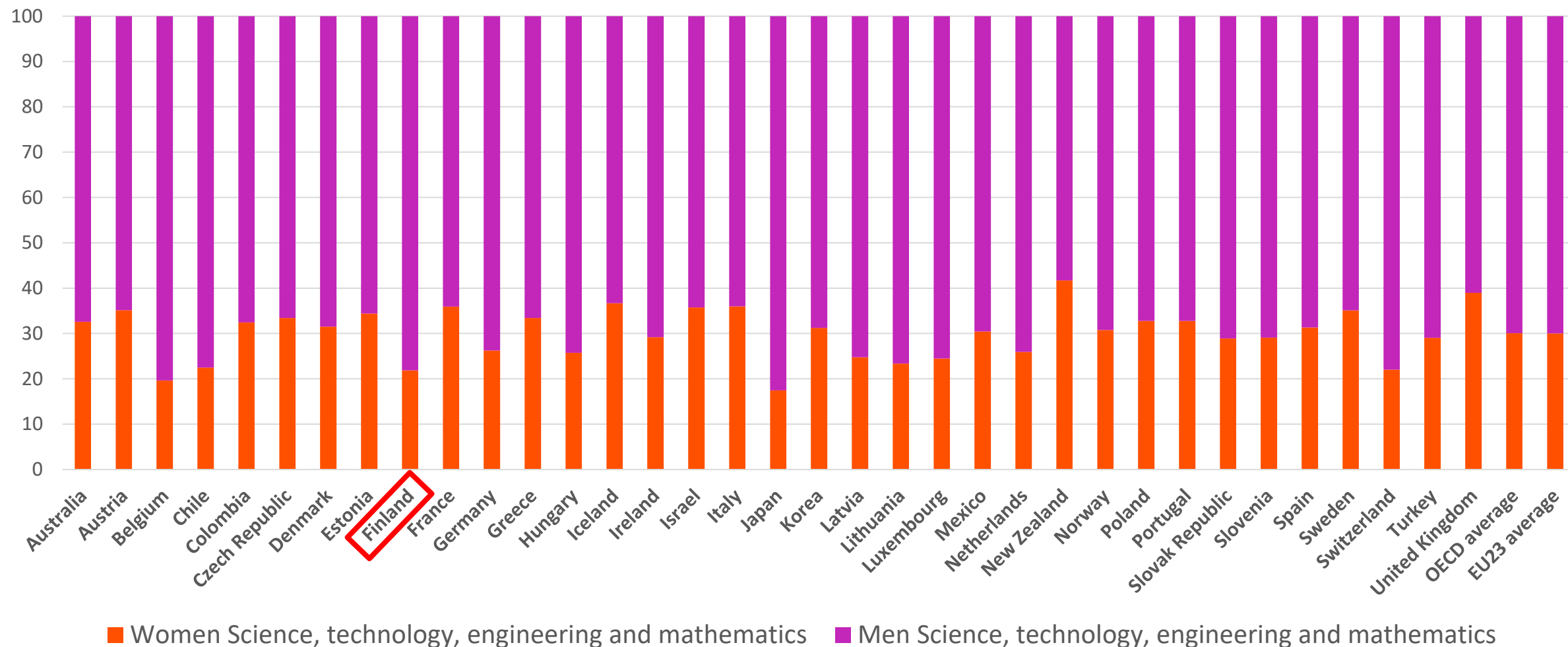

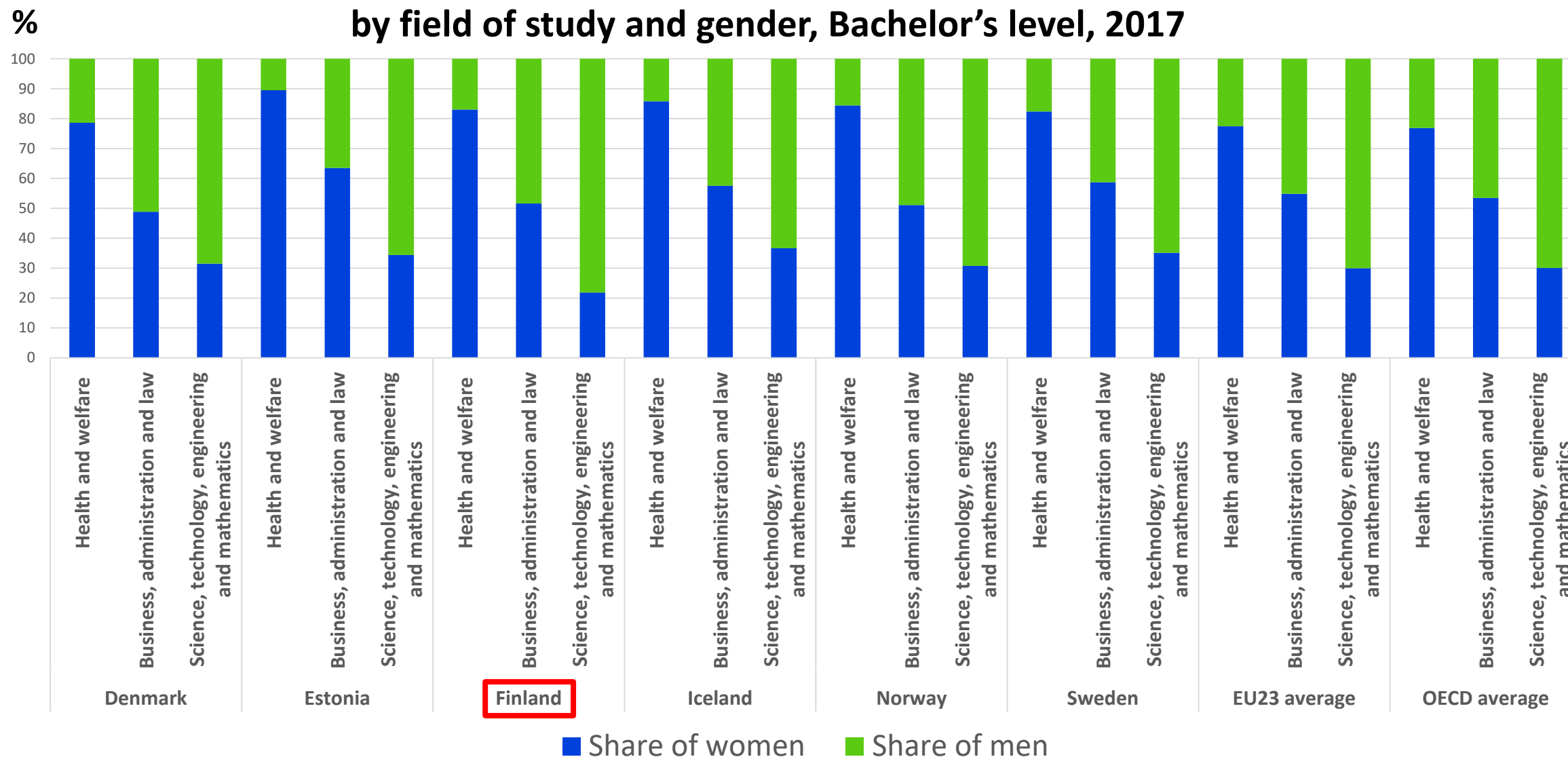
Distribution of first-time entrants by gender, and field of study Bachelor's level, 2017

%

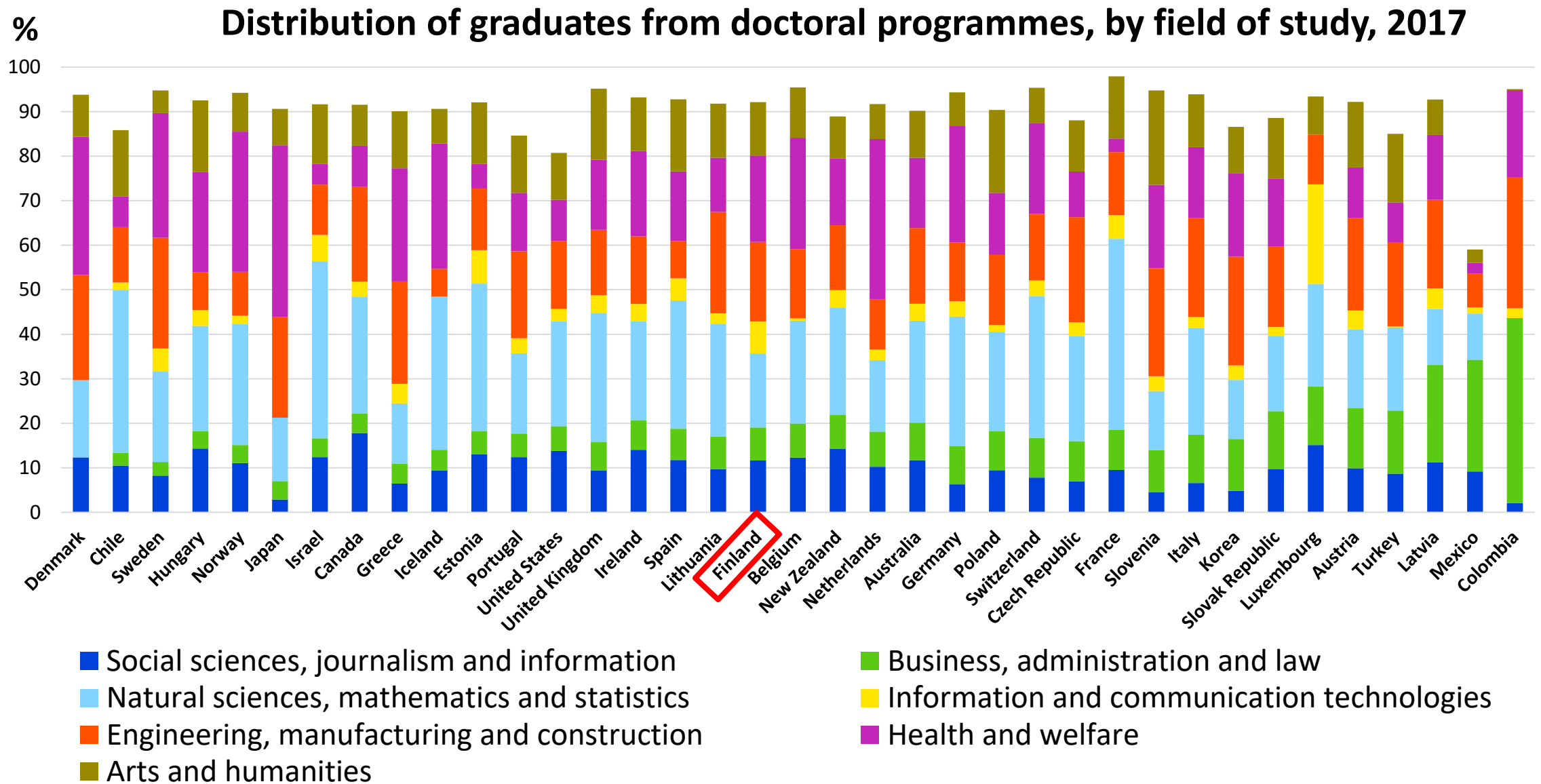

First-time tertiary entrants in the Nordic countries and Estonia by field of study and gender, Bachelor's level, 2017

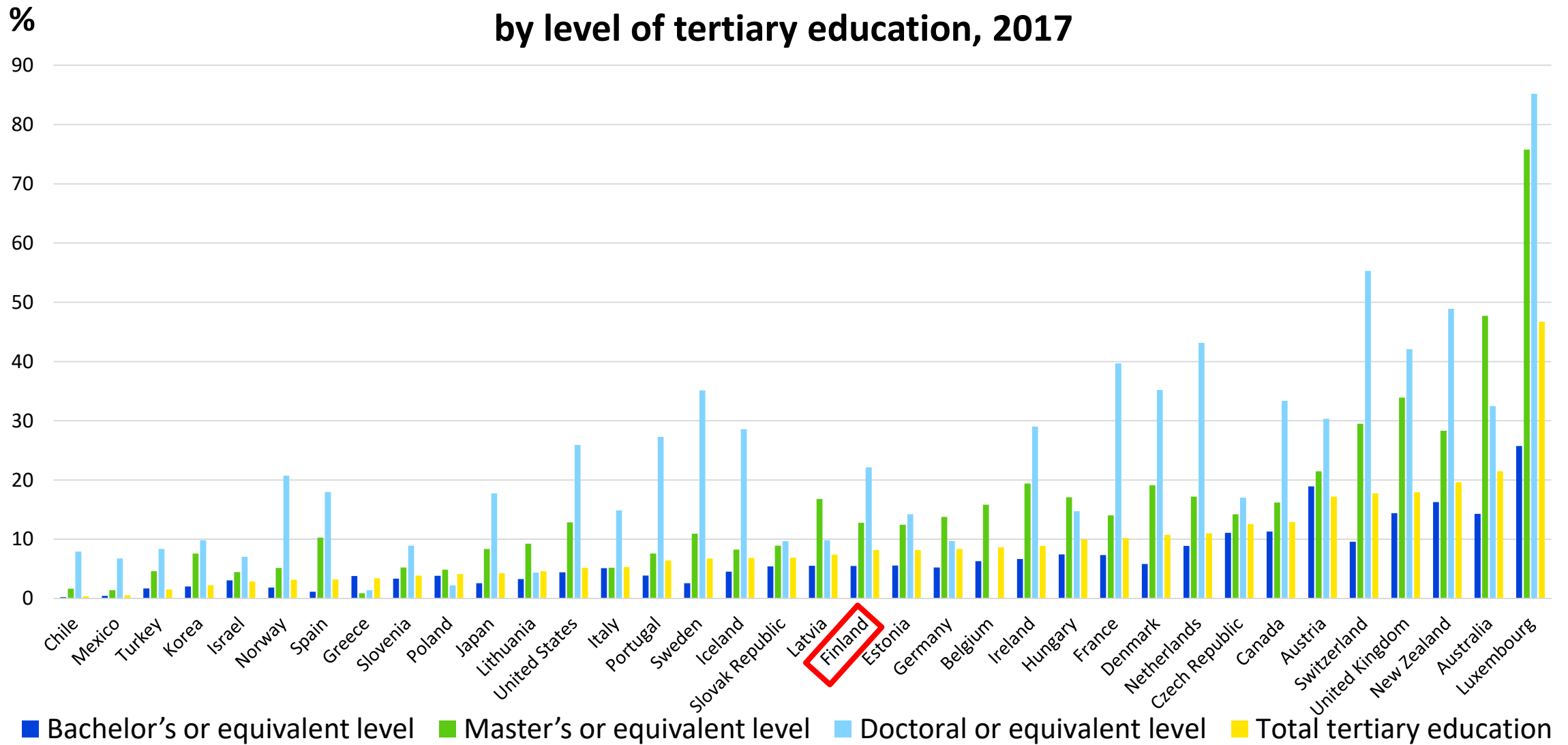

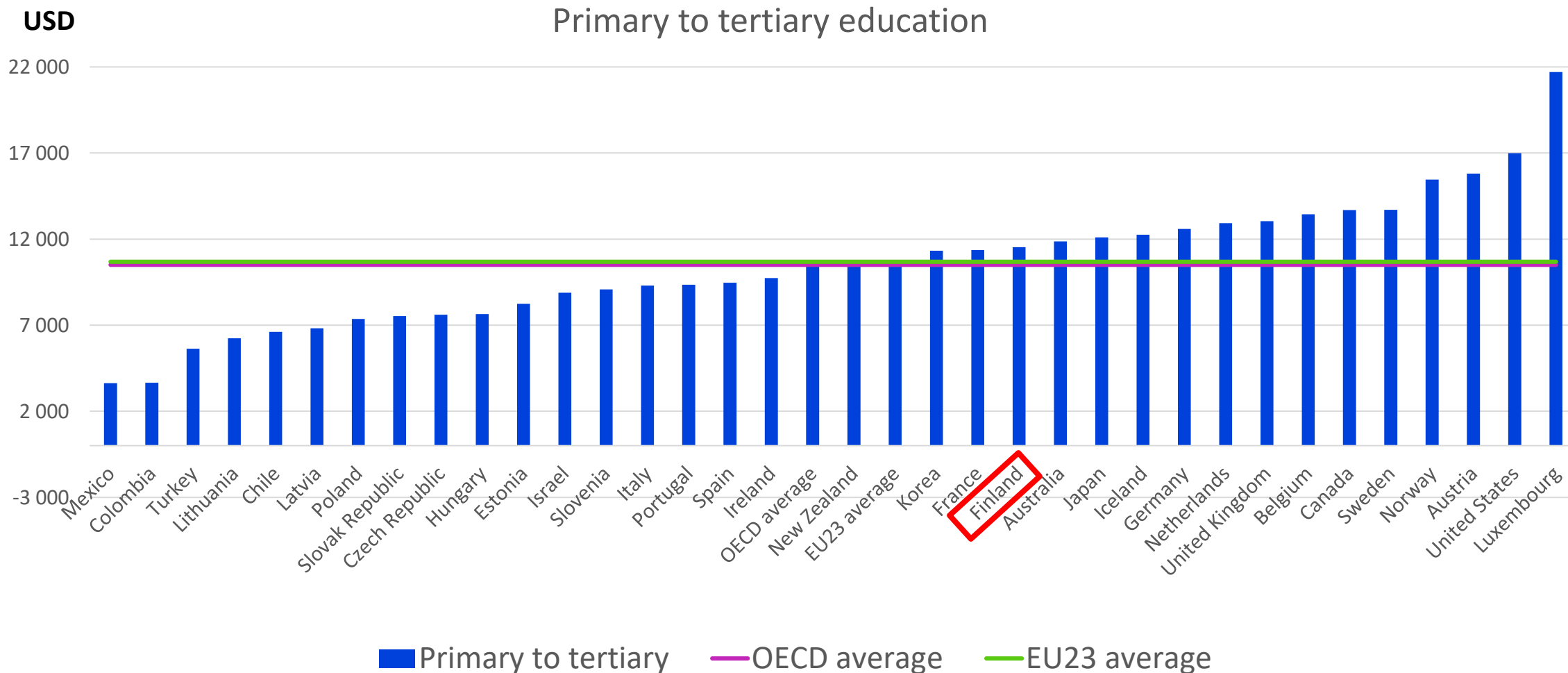
Share of international or foreign students by level of tertiary education, 2017

Primary to tertiary education



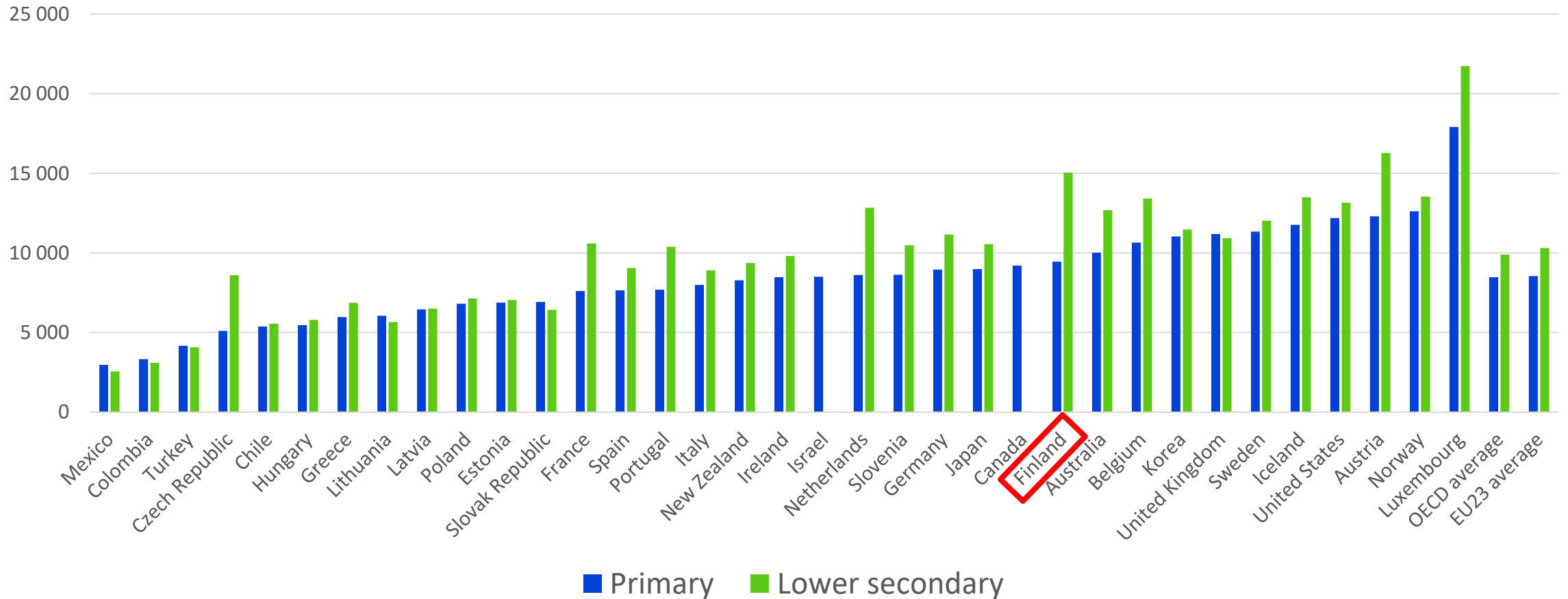

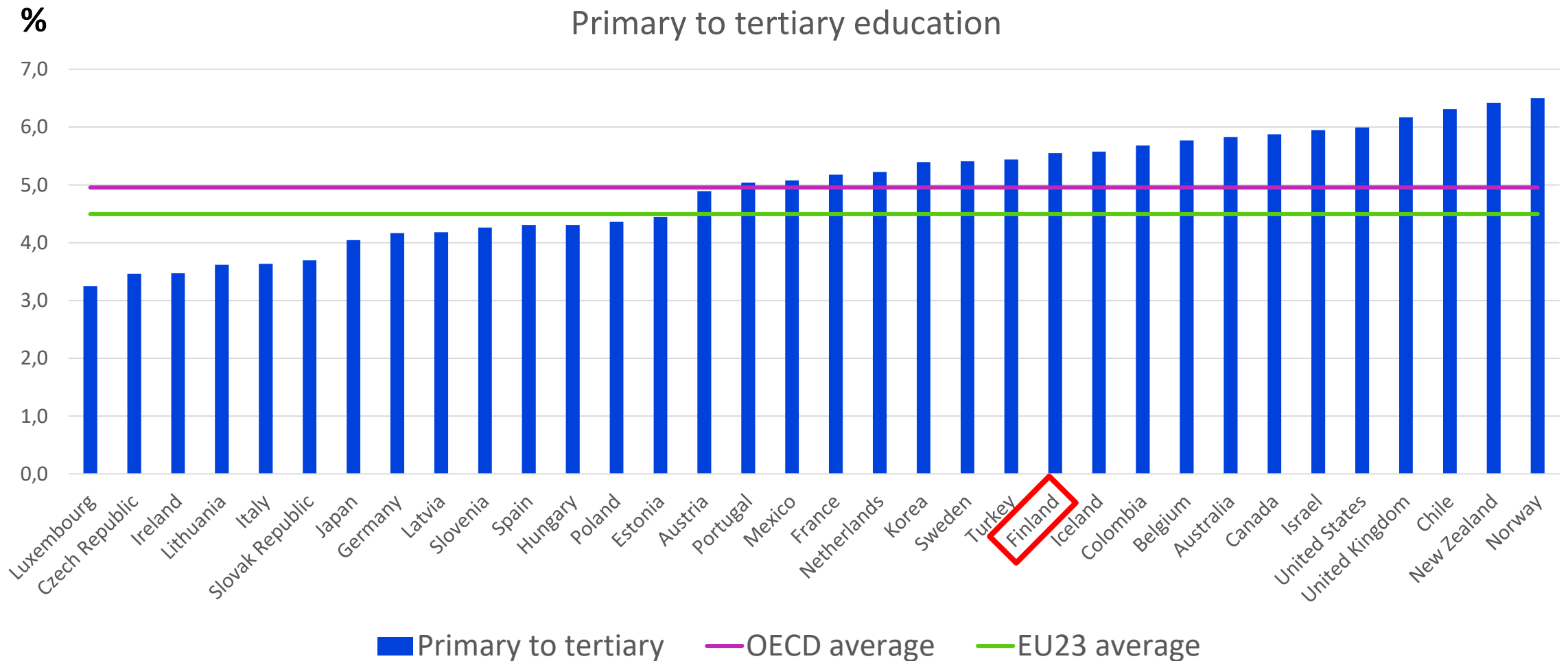

Total expenditure on educational institutions as a percentage of GDP 2016

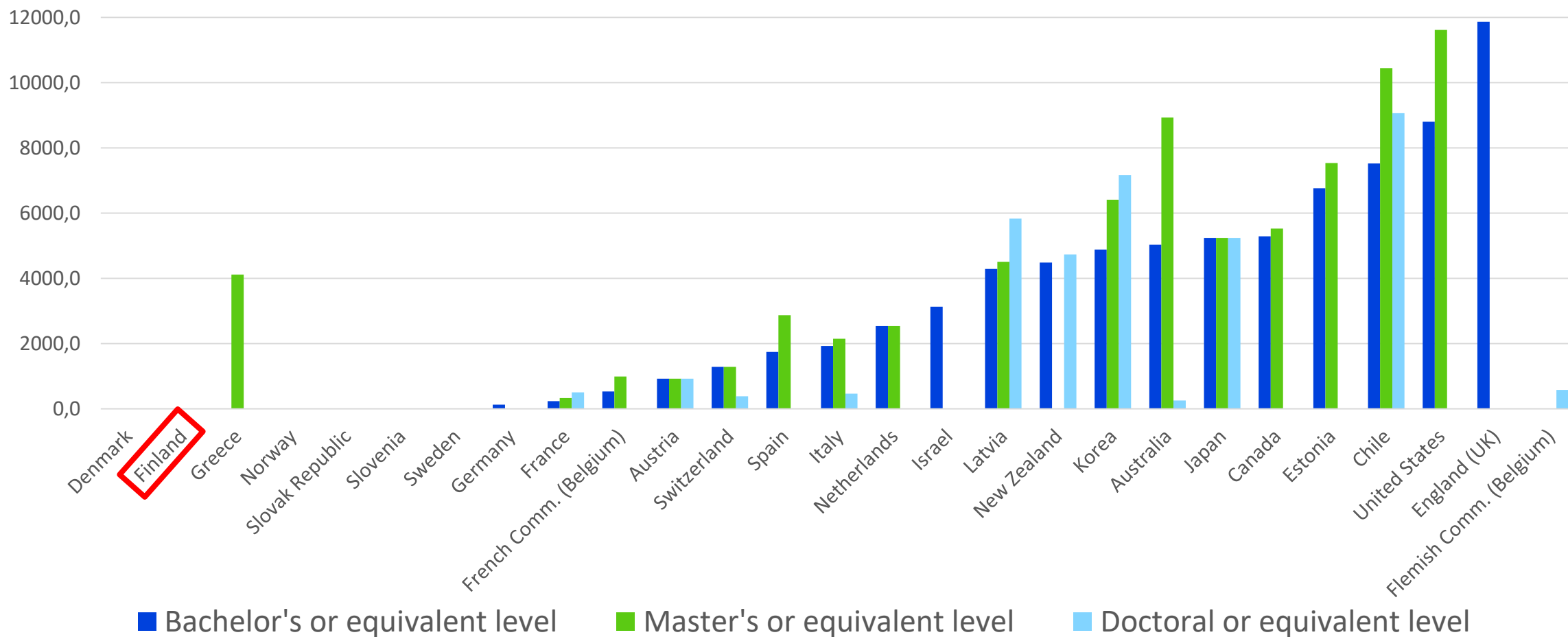

Tuition fees charged by public tertiary educational institutions to national students by level of education, USD*, 2017/18

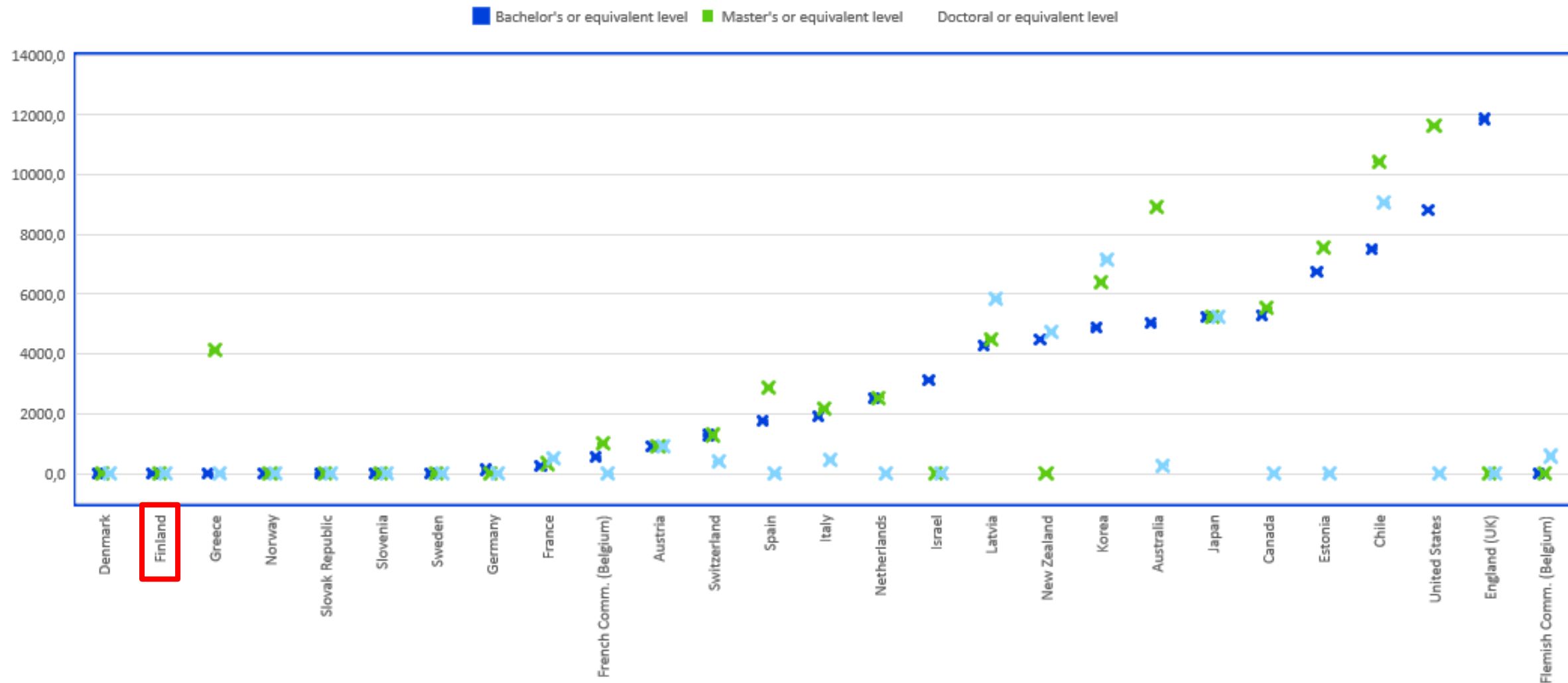

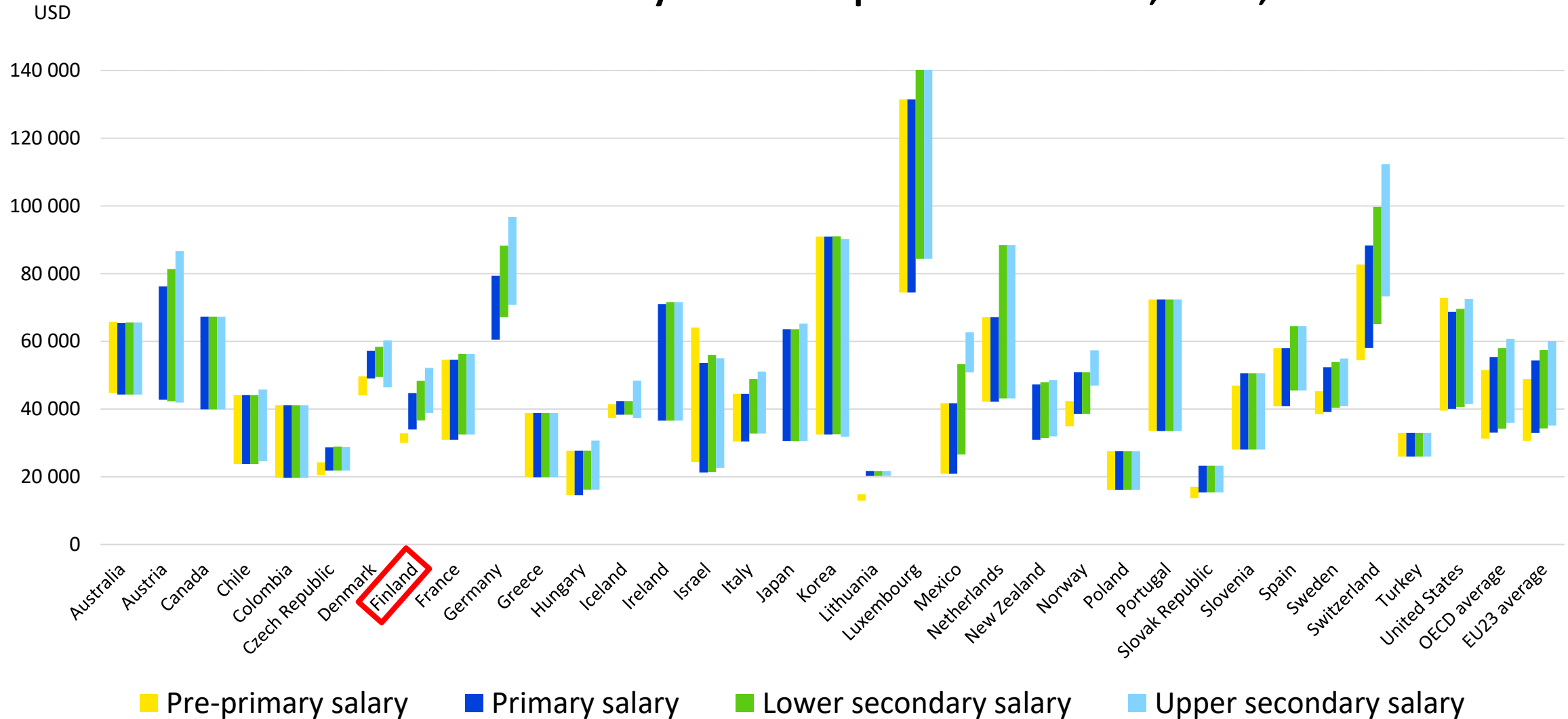

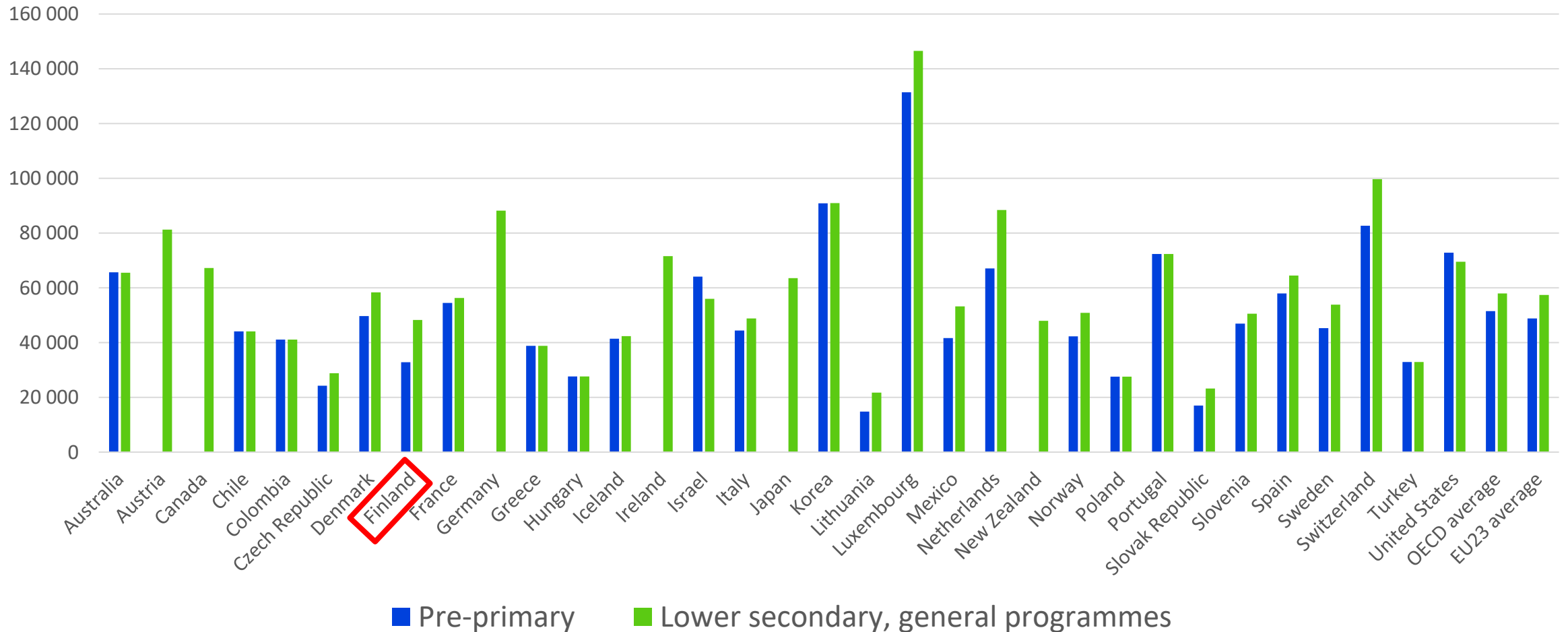
Teachers' annual statutory salaries in public institutions, USD*, 2018

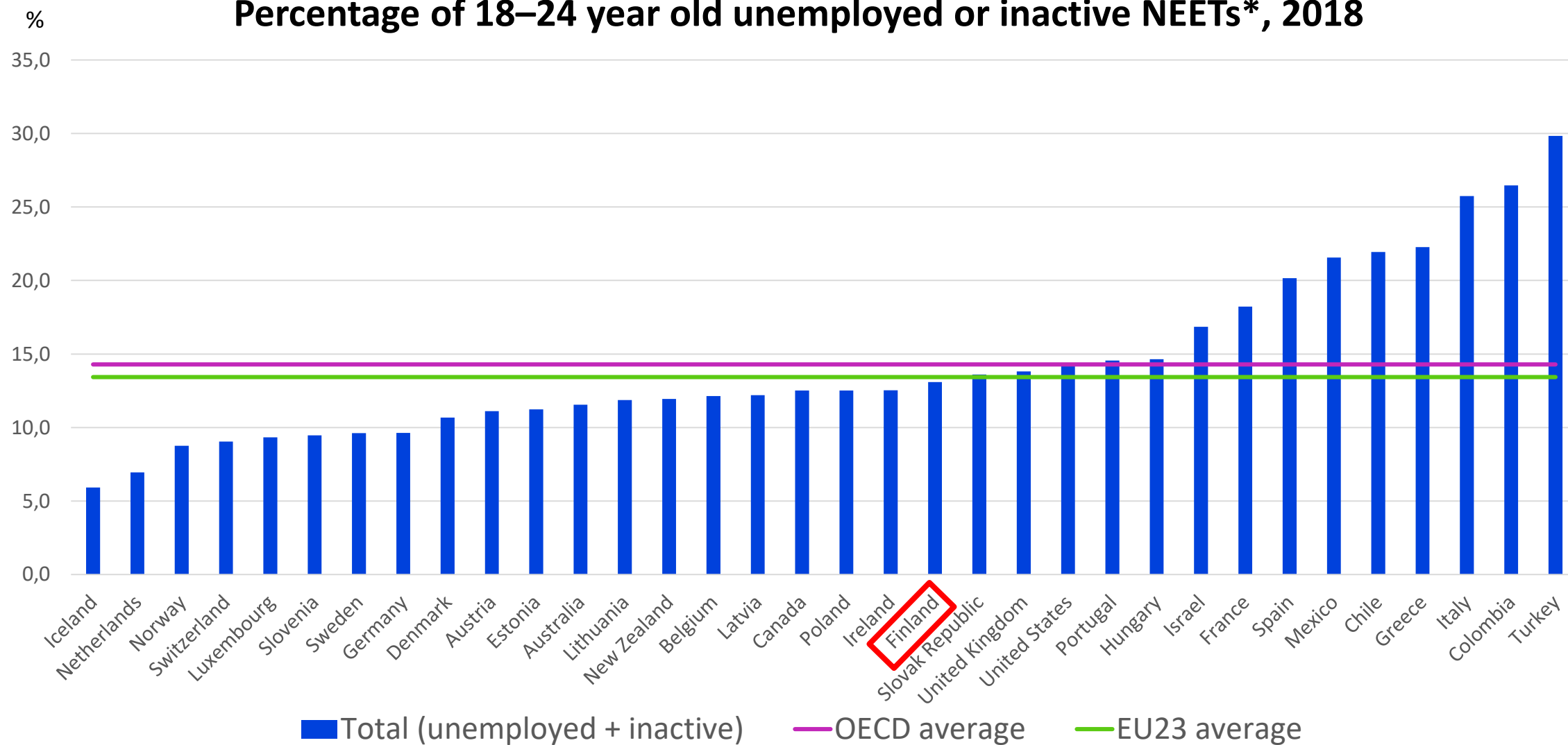
Teachers' annual statutory salaries at top of scale public institutions, USD*, 2018

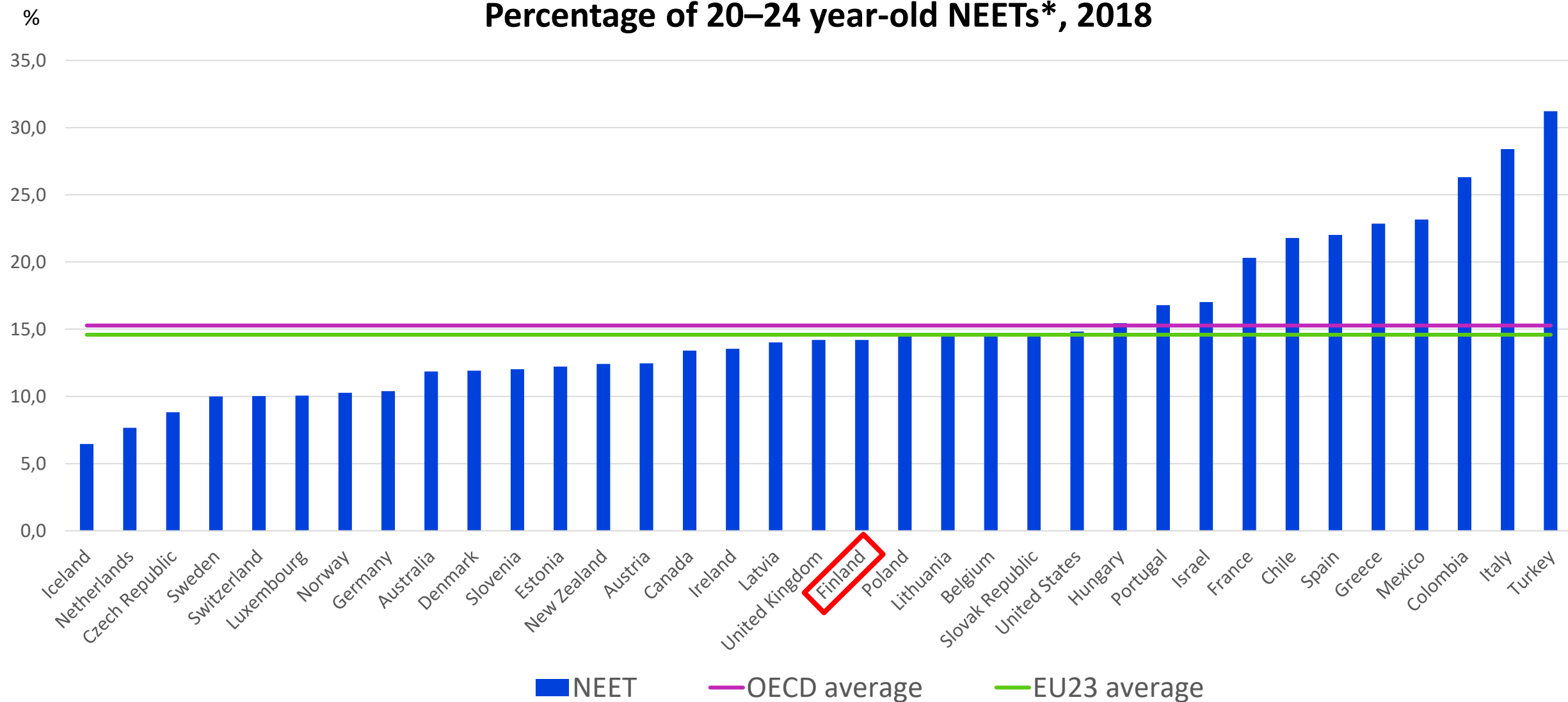
Percentage of 18–24 year old unemployed or inactive NEETs*, 2018
